4.2 Maria Perretta, Executive Director

- ➤ Canada Helps Campaign- During the month of June for every dollar that is donated to RMSS through the Canada Helps website gives us an entry into wining \$20,000. So far total of \$650.
- ➤ Coffee Shops are open outdoors three days a week starting the 5th of July.
- ➢ July marks the last month (fingers crossed) for pre-registration of all programs. We are hoping to return to drop in style for those activities that were drop in prior to the pandemic. BC Government announcements on July 1st will determine next steps for reopening.
- The 120 letters sent to local and country wide foundations to supplement our food service program next year when our Gaming Funds will no longer be available for this program.
