5.1 Liaisons

Councillor Meachen

- Discussion about interest from seniors if the city held an Engagement and Priorities Committee (EPC) meeting in the future
- Government funds for the free farmers markets coupons (Nutrition Coupon Program) are not yet available this year. Last year, \$3081 in coupons were redeemed at the Pitt Meadows Farmers Market.

5.2 Maria Perretta, Executive Director

- Bus Banter
 - Sessions were held at both centres last week with total of 22 in attendance to discuss the need and ideas about running a community bus between both RMSS centres with strategic stops along the route.
 - Service would be available to all seniors, not just RMSS members
 - A survey will be coming out to get more feedback

- McLean Developer Donation
 - MOU is being drafted
- All three United Way grant applications were successful for a total of \$359,920
 - TAPS (Therapeutic Recreation Activity Program) through United Way- \$199, 920 This program will run alongside of our Caregivers Support Program to offer a day program for seniors with mild to moderate cognitive or mobility impairments. Group activities will be lead by a Recreation Therapist. This will be a free program.
 - United Way Caregivers Support Program-\$ 110,000 This will help us to expand our current Caregiver Support Program into satellite locations to assist more people looking after seniors who live at home.
 - United Way Social Meals Program- \$50,000- to support our breakfast & lunch buddies programs which is an opportunity for seniors to have a free nutritious meal in a congregate organized setting in an effort to reduce isolation and promote socialization.
- Two other grant applications were successful
 - Community Prosperity Fund through the Maple Ridge Community Foundation- \$92,500 The goal of this funding is to make a significant impact addressing social isolation while easing food costs for RMSS volunteers.
 - Petro Canada Caremakers- \$7000 to provide free meals to ease the burden of caregivers looking after seniors living at home.
 - Grand total of all five successful grants is \$507,420
- Mrs. Ropers Romp held at Pitt Meadows Activity Centre on April 10 was a success and was reported in the Maple Ridge News
- April 30 is the 'Accessibility Exploration Event' held at Pitt Meadows City Hall in the Meadows Room from 1-3 pm
- May 3 is 'Volunteer Appreciation Day' held at the Maple Ridge Activity Centre; the theme is 'Magical'
- Oct 1 is 'National Senior Day' with an event to be held at Maple Ridge Activity Centre; call out for any seniors who are entertainers
- Oct 25 is the Wellness Fair held by the Seniors Network at Maple Ridge Activity Centre

- BC Hydro did a lighting assessment at Maple Ridge Activity Centre
- All lights will be changed to LED at a cost of \$59,000 to the City; the projected annual cost savings to the City will be \$7000

- Patricia reported that the Coffee Fundraiser was officially open online to accept sales from April 14 to May 12. Emphasis on shop local and support seniors in our community. Nine orders already received.
- Second Annual Shred-a-thon booked for Sat. June 14, 2025 in the Maple Ridge Activity Centre parking lot. Cash donations of minimum \$25 for a 'bankers box' or \$10 for a plastic grocery bag.
 - Three sponsors have been secured to cover the cost of the onsite secure shredding truck supplied by RecordXPress.
 - Sponsors are Johnston Meier Insurance, Absolute Hearing and Janet Helms, realtor; all have established relationships with RMSS
