7.2 Wellness Fair


- Oct. 25, 2025 Wellness Fair put on by Seniors Network at Maple Ridge Activity Centre went very well with over 100 in attendance
- RMSS will be the home to future Wellness Fair events


7.3 Perimeter Work at Maple Ridge Activity Centre

- The work has begun to fix the problem and will be completed by the end of the week


8.0 Adjournment
